Spring	Months of March, April and May
Summer	Months of June, July and August.
Autumn	Months of September, October and November.
Winter	Months of December, January and February.

Key Information

- The 4 seasons are Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter.
- In spring, the days become longer.
- The hours of daylight become longer.
- Plants start to grow.
- The leaves on deciduous trees begin to grow.
- Some animals will come out of hibernation.

Season

Average hours of daylight

Winter	8 hours
Spring	13 hours
Summer	16 hours
Autumn	11 hours
