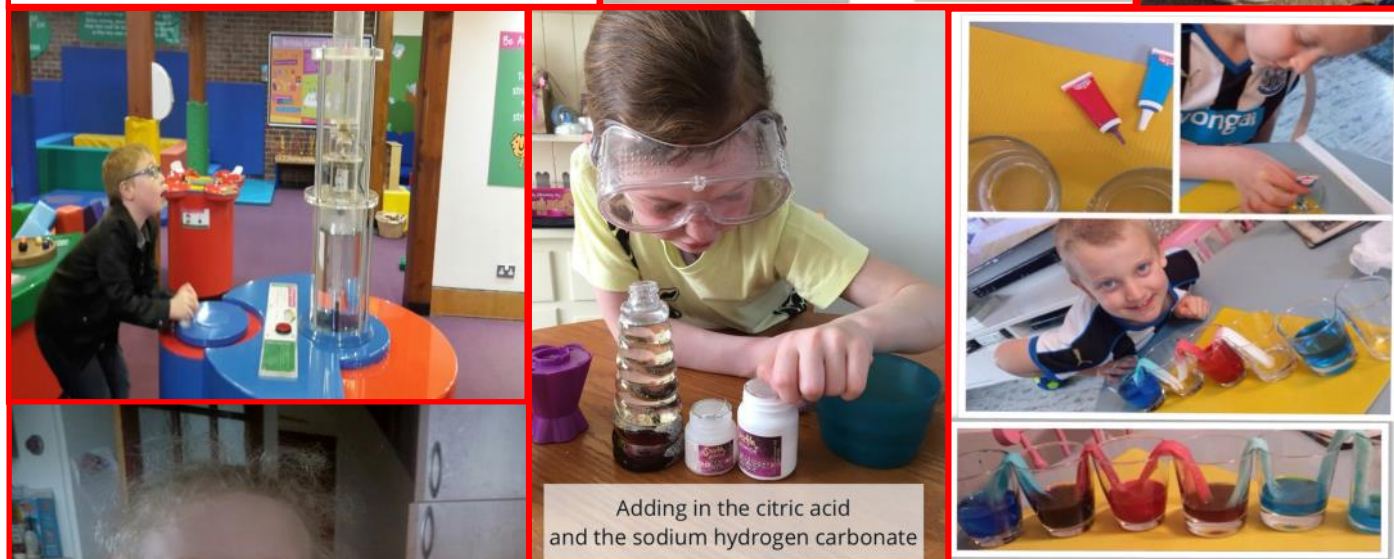
Orry had a fantastic time!

Please let us know if you are worried about your child's attendance, and would like our support.



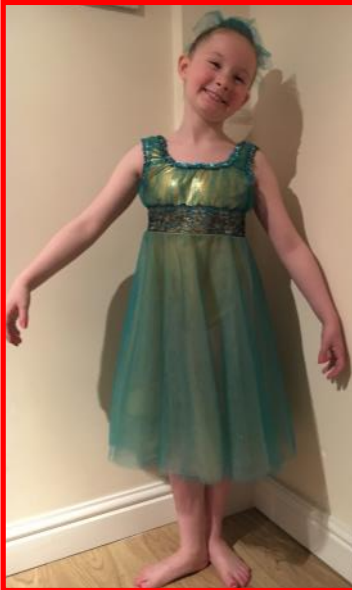

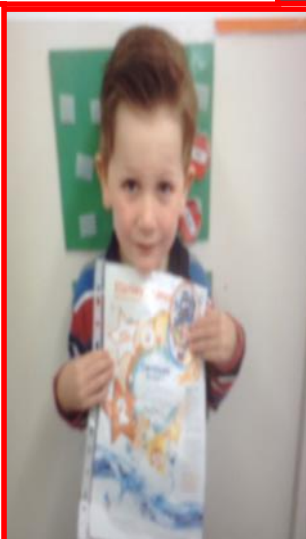


Rachel, Isabel and Sophia all had a great time doing the TOG Run. They brought their medals in to show us.
