
Our Vision Display

A MESSAGE FROM NORTH TYNESIDE COUNCIL

During the decision making process, in August 2015, in relation to the setting of Term and Holiday dates for the academic year 16/17, Cabinet requested that for future years, a consultation be held with Schools, parents and the wider public, to explore factors that might influence the structure of future Term and Holiday dates. We are now

considering the structure of the term and holiday dates for the academic year 2017/2018.

The outcome and preferred option will be considered by Cabinet on 15^{th} August.


