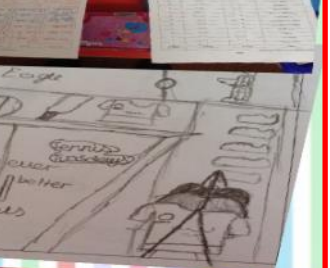
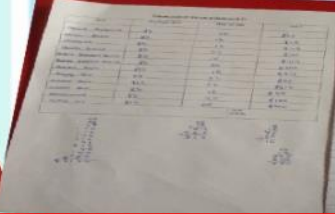
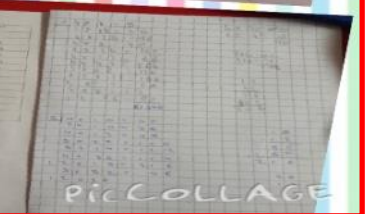

Year 6 Enterprise

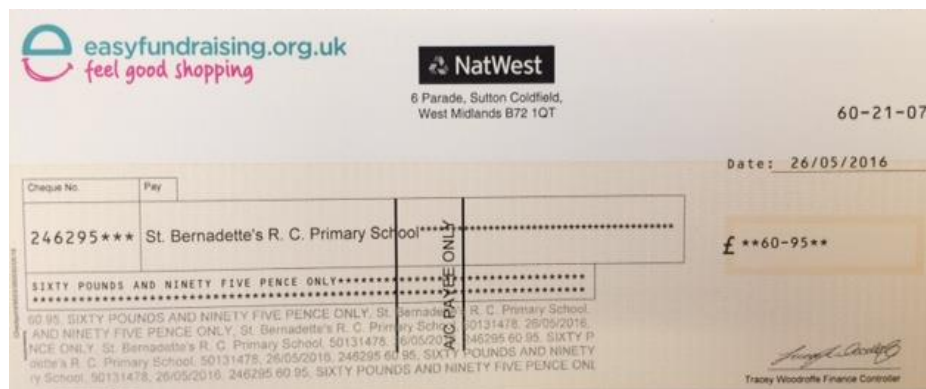
