Gates Times



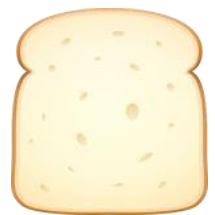
The gates to school will not be opened until 8.40am as we use the outside space for clubs before school.
