In our mission to help save our beautiful planet, we have now signed up with Tetracycle to recycle crisp packets and in return we receive points which can then be converted to money for our school.



### **Nursery Places Available**


St. Bernadette's Nursery still have a couple of Nursery places for three year olds available for September 2019.
