


This year the theme of the festival was "Icons".

Throughout the day Secret Readers surprised their children by turning up to read stories. We had some very surprised faces. Each class had chance to do a book swap in the afternoon.


Thank you to everyone who came along or contributed in any way. The children really enjoyed their World Book Day.





