Thank you to all the parents and grandparents who gave up their time to join us. We hope you enjoyed a moment of reflection.





#### Baby Equipment Loan Service

The Baby Equipment Loan Service & Toy Library (BELS & TL) is a charity responding to local needs since 1985. The Project provides, for loan at minimal cost, essential items of baby and safety equipment e.g. buggies, cots and highchairs to families on low income or benefits living in North Tyneside. In 2003 we established a Toy Library for children 0 to 15 years of age, stocking it with safe, educational, age appropriate, stimulating and fun items.

When customers can come into the Project to hire baby and safety equipment (delivery service available if necessary). When children, parents and carers can access all of the toys, games and other play equipment


We are so proud of Ava for achieving her very first distance award of 5m in swimming. It is going to be the first of many-I am certain. Well done, Ava!
