Literacy

This half term we will be reading stories from fantasy settings and focusing on our Space topic. Texts include 1,2,3... off to the sea, Moon-Budees, Beegu, Q Pootle 5 & Whatever Next.

We will be using Talk 4 Writing to learn stories and retell them. We will talking about the characters and the settings and drawing our own story maps. We will be writing lists, labels and captions.

We will also be reading simple poems and rhymes and recognising rhyming words. We will be writing rhymes as a class using shared writing.



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Numeracy

Number skills and Place value - We will continue to count, order and write numbers to 20 and beyond.

We will work on place value looking at what each digit represents.

We will be working out one more and one less to 20 and will begin to count in 10s

Addition - We will begin addition, using the vocabulary add, plus, more than, count on and will use our addition skills to solve simple number problems

Shape - We will name and describe 2D and 3D shapes

Spelling, Phonics, Grammar and Punctuation

We will be teaching the age expected spellings as well as revisiting phonic patterns and tricky words.
