Computing

This half term we will be digital art. We will also have access to IPads to support work across the curriculum.

We will be develop control of the mouse.

PSHCE

We currently follow the SEAL curriculum and our topic this term is 'Relationships'
We will be exploring friendship through Anti-Bullying Week and developing our Mission work through 'Compassion'

MUSIC

We will be working with a music specialist to explore sounds and rhythm.

We be learning new songs for our Nativity performance.

Educational visits and outdoor learning

We will be going on walks in and around the school to explore seasonal change as part of our science topic.

We will be having a special visit from the Christmas Elf to collect our letters to Santa.

Literacy

We will be reading stories and rhymes such as Polar Bear, Polar Bear What do you hear?, In Arctic Waters.

We will talk about the characters and events in stories, retell and act out stories, listen for rhymes, describe the characters and write rhymes in the style of the books.

We will also read non-fiction texts to find out about polar animals, weather, homes and transport and we will talk about the differences between fiction and non-fiction texts and identify the features of non-fiction texts. We will write our own information pages about the Arctic.

Maths

We will continue to count, order and write numbers to 20 and beyond.

We will continue adding and use our adding skills to solve simple number problems in real life situations. We will be counting in 10s and recognising odd and even numbers

We will be talking about our daily routines and then reading o'clock times. We will also be solving simple problems, for example one hour before and one hour after.

Phonics, Grammar and Punctuation

We will be teaching the age expected spellings as well as revisiting phonic patterns and tricky words.

We will be learning about nouns, verbs and adjectives and using correct punctuation Consistently.

Across Key Stage 1 we will be continuing our daily phonics lessons. Children will work in mixed phonics groups and there will be ongoing assessment to ensure the children are accessing the relevant phonics programme.

Science

This half term we will be learning to name and label Arctic Mammals and discuss how their offspring grow to look like them. We will be exploring the terms carnivores, omnivore and herbivore.

We will be revisiting **Seasonal Change** and looking at the changes in Winter.

Homework

In Key Stage 1 the children will have homework books which will include a note each week which sets out the homework and when it should be returned. The homework will focus on basic skills, number, handwriting and sometimes topic based activities.
