Hard At Work!

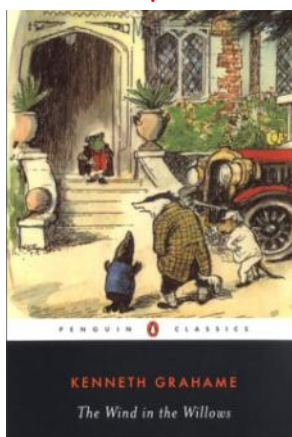
This week on our blog, we thought we would like to share with you some of the exciting learning opportunities that we have had across the school this week.

They have been exploring and experimenting with various artistic techniques that illustrators use to capture their characters. They have been inspired by the vivid and rich character descriptions.



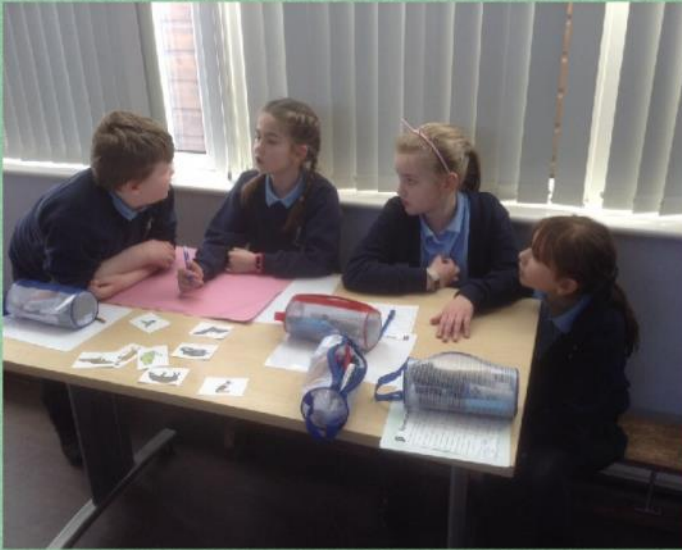
Learning Lessons In Lent



Nursery have been learning all about Lent and the importance of being kind to each other in lots of different ways.



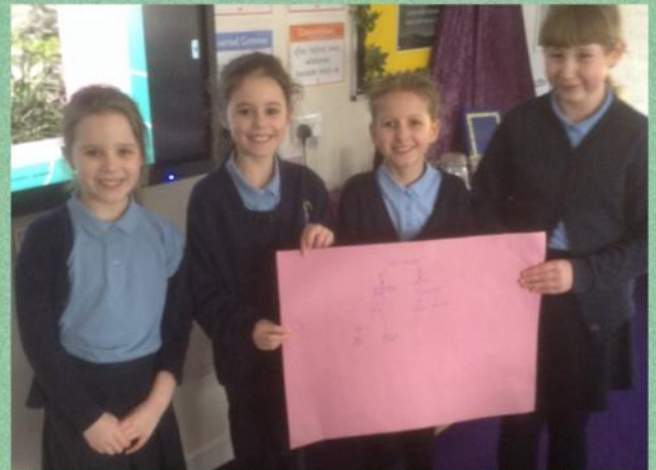
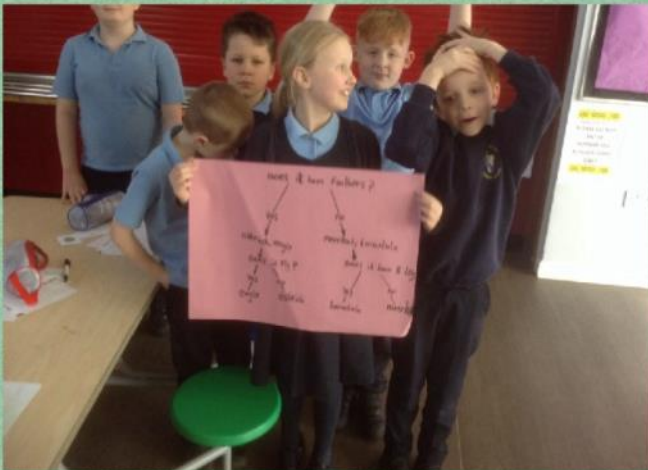
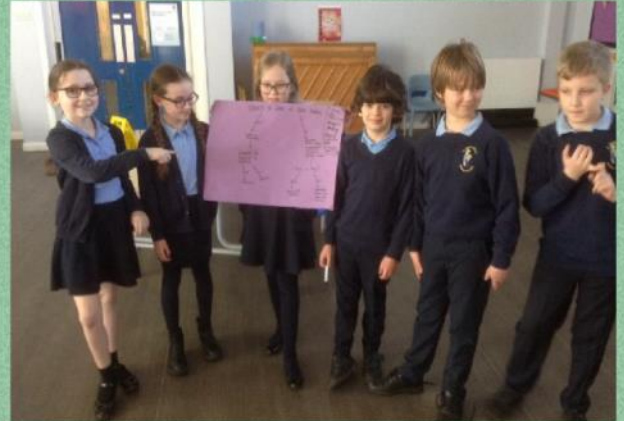
Science in Year 4



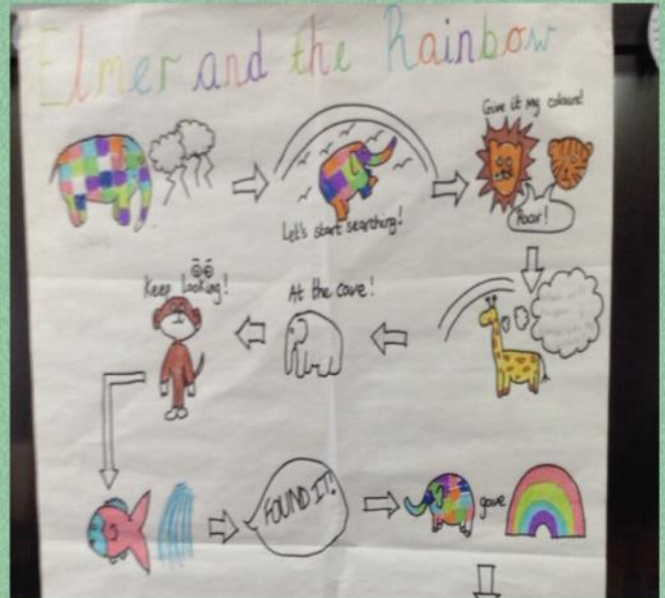
LI: To explore and use a classification key to group and identify living things in their habitat.

Storytelling in Year 1/2



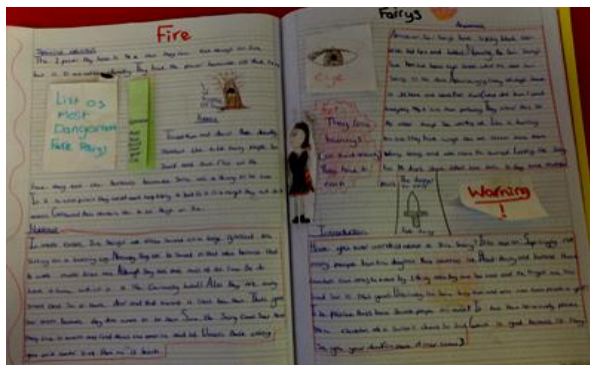
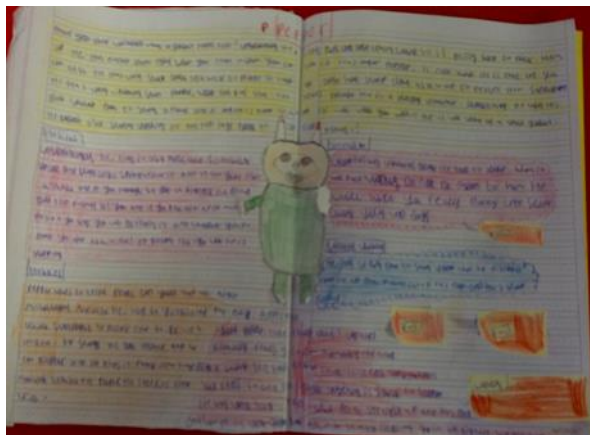
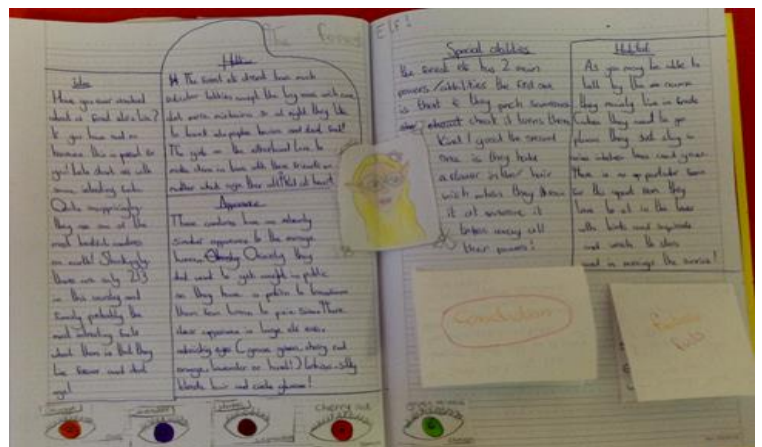
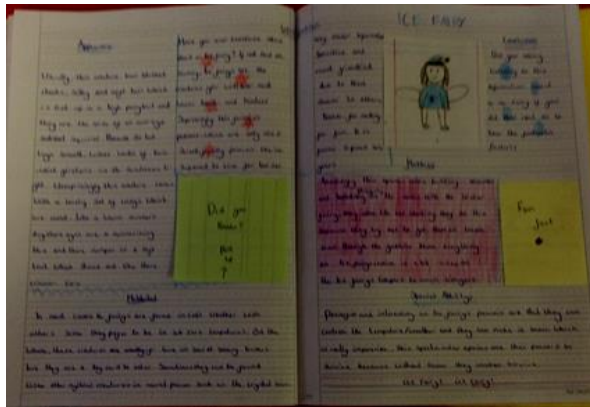
Over the past two weeks in year 1/2 we have been learning about Elmer. We created a story map and actions to help us to retell the story.
