
This week on our blog, we thought we would like to share with you some of the exciting learning opportunities that we have had across the school this week.

They have been exploring and experimenting with various artistic techniques that illustrators use to capture their characters. They have been inspired by the vivid and rich character descriptions.









Children worked in groups to create a classification key for the habitat they were given, eg. a desert, ocean, woodland.



Storytelling in Year 1/2












Over the past two weeks in year 1/2 we have been learning about Elmer. We created a story map and actions to help us to retell the story.












Year 5 and the Spiderwick Chronides


