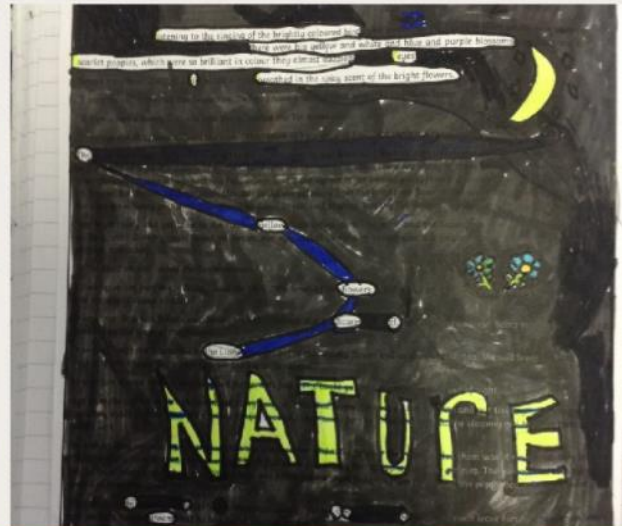
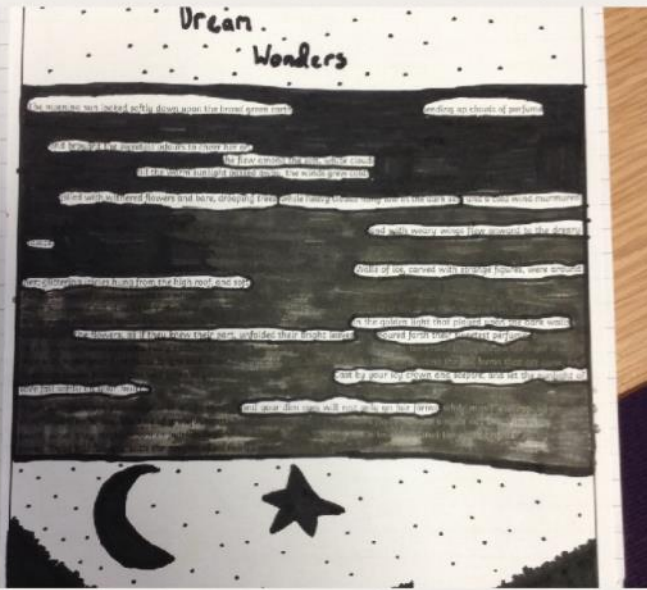


Testing Times!

Here are Year 4 testing a variety of materials to see if they are good conductors of Electricity as part of their work in Science.



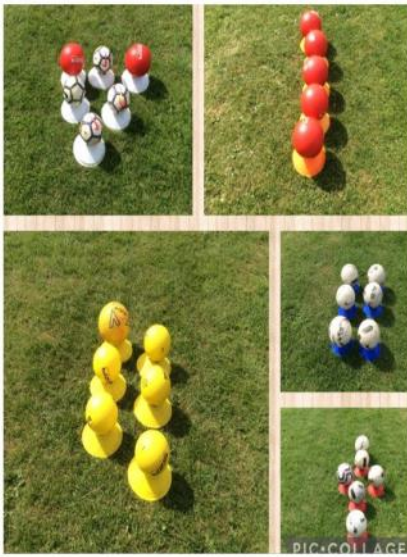
