Important lessons for us all to learn.

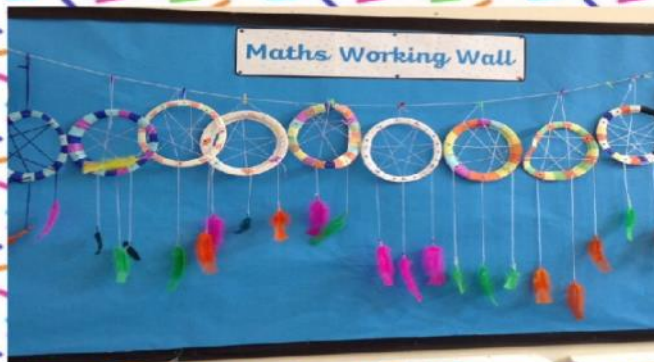


The children considered our impact on the earth, why we need to protect creation and how we can do this.

This half term our topic is Dreams so UKS2 have made their own gorgeous dreamcatchers.



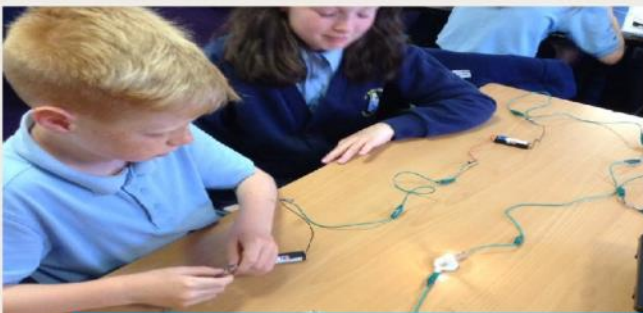
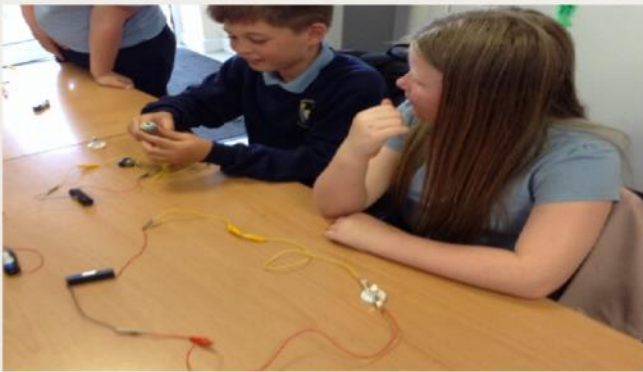

SVP (Byker) - a charity who work with local homeless people and families who are in need.

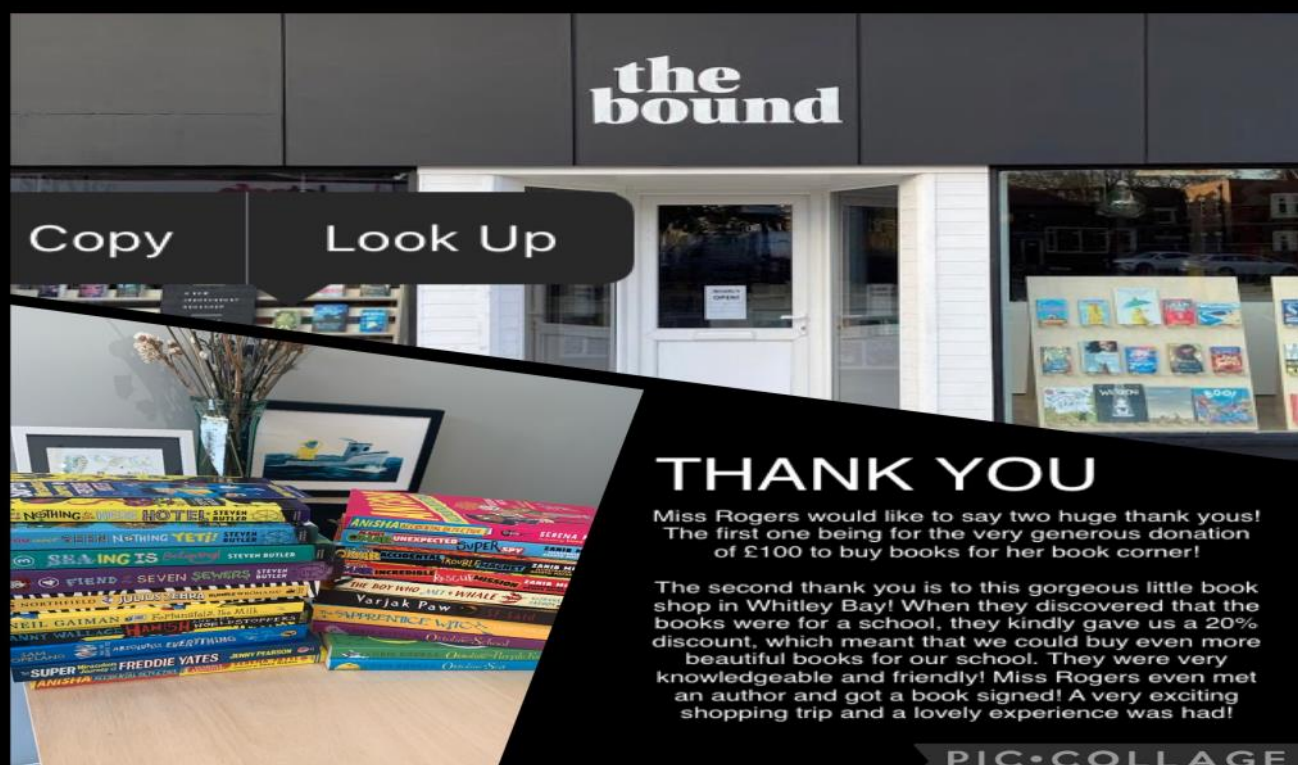
