Leavers' Trips

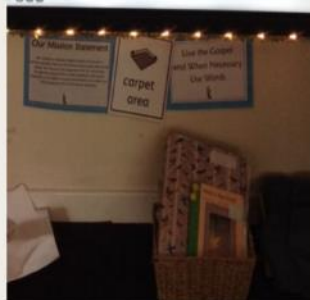


Merci Mme Walton!

Ethan, Jack and Rauri all passed their kickboxing grading on Saturday. They will now move up to yellow belt!

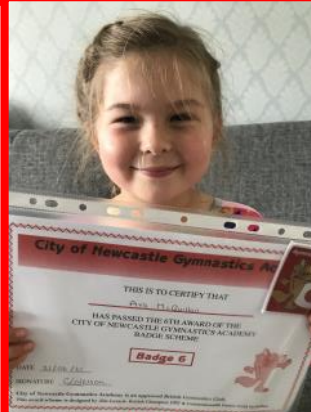
Congratulations lads!!

Ava was thrilled to receive her Badge 6 in Gymnastics this week.

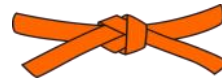
She has worked very hard and we are very proud of her.
