There are cuttings and seedlings appearing on window sills around the school. The children have also been busy preparing the flower beds in the coals wagons, at the front of school.

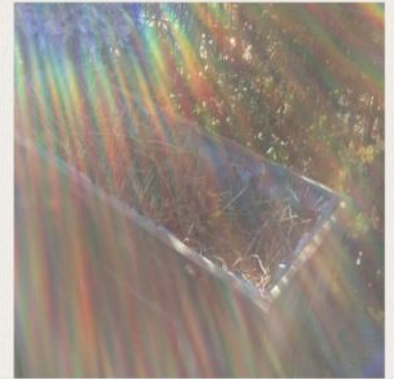
Mrs Collins has been busy researching which flowers are traditionally linked to Our Lady.
