

As part of this term's study of the Arts, LKS2 have been looking at the works of Antony Gormley.


Strange little sculpted characters have been seen in lots of places.

We are thrilled for you, Lloyd!




Joshua has earned the highest award at cubs, that it is possible to get. It is the chief scout silver award.

Best of luck!!!




Luca with his Saturday team Burnopfield Blacks under 11s this week won the league - the top division out of 15 leagues.
