New Lunch Menus


Look out for Dot's new lunch menus which begin after the half term holiday next week.

This has to be the generation that will save the our planet for the future.




Half Term Holiday next week!

St. Bernadette's Nursery still have a couple of Nursery places for three year olds available for September 2019.


Both 15 hours and 30 hours placements are available.
