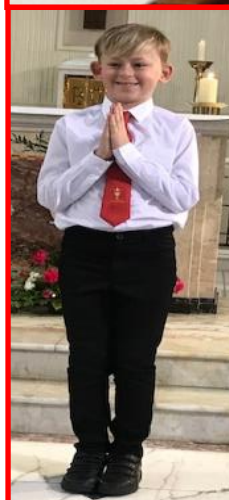

Year 3 Liturgy

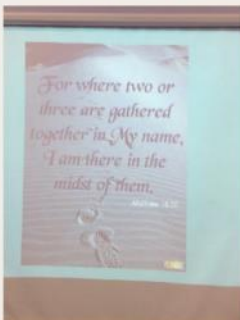


On Wednesday the children in Mrs Gibbins class led our KS2 Liturgy.

This has to be the generation that will save the our planet for the future.



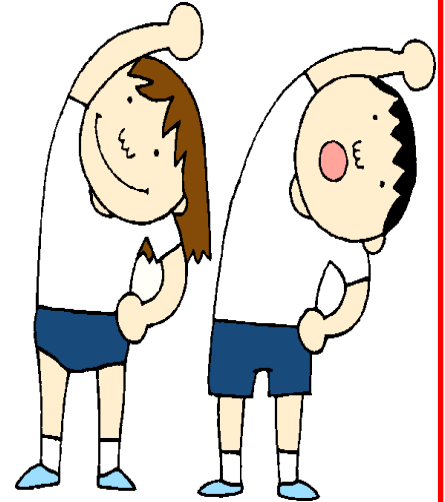

Berwick and London Trips

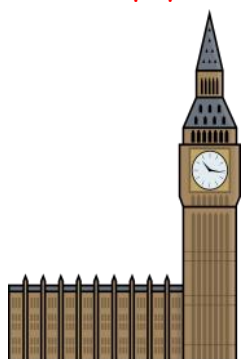
Final payment dates for the upcoming trips to London and Berwick are getting closer!

That is just **TWO** weeks to go!



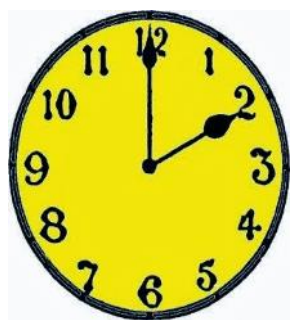
