Year 2 spent an exciting day at Gibside, den building and on a minibeast hunt. Great fun was had by all!

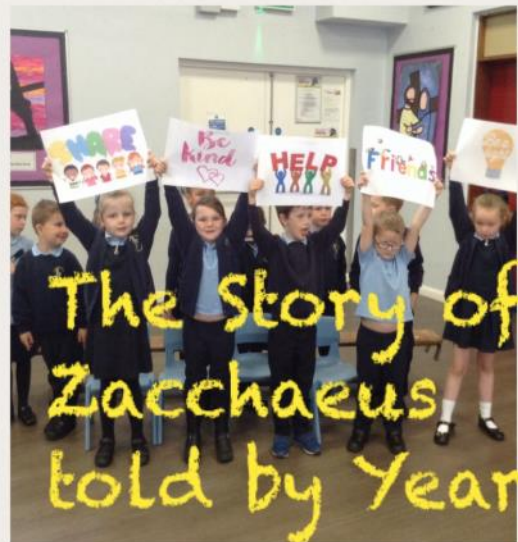


Year 1 Class Liturgy

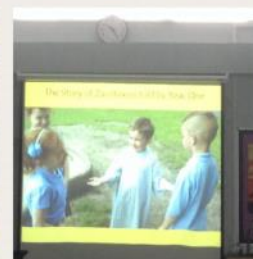
On Wednesday morning our Year 1 class led the KS1 Liturgy.

National Refugee Week

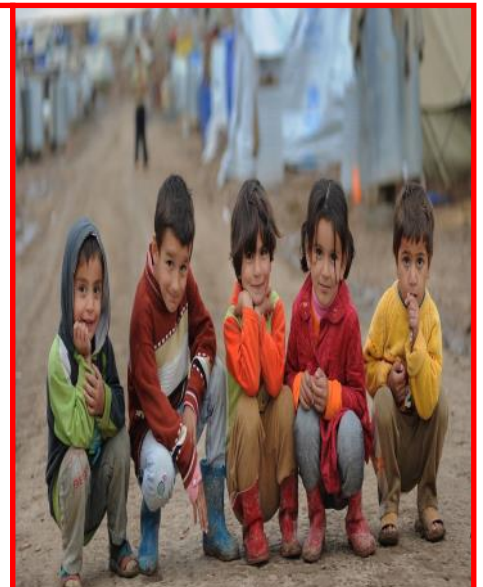
Almighty and merciful God,

Gates Times



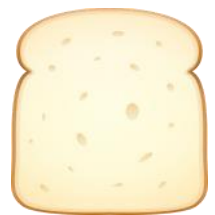
The gates to school will not be opened until 8.40am as we use the outside space for clubs before school.
