

## FROM WEDNESDAY 12 SEPTEMBER 2018, YOU CAN APPLY FOR THEIR PLACE

If you live in North Tyneside apply online at www.northtyneside.gov.uk Alternatively you can complete a paper application form.

### Apply if:

- Your child is due to start school for the first time, in September 2019
- Your child will move to the next stage of education, in September 2019 (for example from first to middle, from middle to high, or from primary to secondary)

It's quick, simple and secure to apply online at www.northtyneside.gov.uk

We'll confirm your application by email and you can change details on your application up until the deadline dates.

You will also receive earlier confirmation of which school your child has been offered.

### **Application deadlines:**

Your application needs to be submitted by:

31 October, 2018 for middle and high school applications.

15 January, 2019 for first and primary school applications.

Full details of the council's admission procedures, and how to apply, are available at www.northtyneside.gov.uk and in 'The Essential Guide to North Tyneside Schools' brochure.
