The Admissions Online is now open. Posters displaying information on display in school porch and on parents' noticeboard.

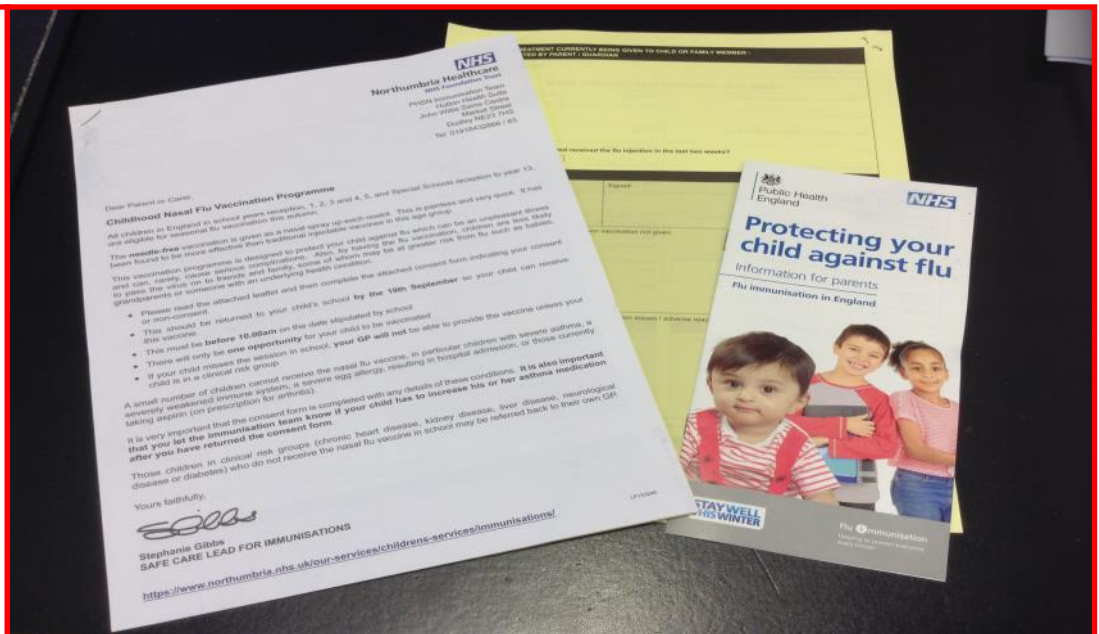


Flu Vaccine
